

TAP FEES

1. Each user, at the time they are connected with the waterworks system, shall pay a charge to cover the cost of excavating and tapping the main, furnishing and laying service pipe from the main to the property line, corporation and stop cocks, service and meter box and installing the 5/8" meter. The charge for a single 5/8" meter tap shall be \$1,960.00.
2. Each user installing dual meters within the same meter pit, at the time they are connected with the waterworks system, shall pay a charge to cover the cost of furnishing and installing the connecting yoke bar, copper setter and the second 5/8" meter in addition to the cost of installing the first 5/8" meter. The charge for the second 5/8" meter tap shall be \$517.00, in addition to the first 5/8" meter tap of \$1,960.00.
3. The charge for a tap larger than the 5/8" meter tap will be the cost of labor and materials, but not less than \$1,960.00.
4. If a Tap Fee is prepaid and the consumer does not request actual connection to the waterworks system within 90 days of payment, the consumer must pay the Tap Fee in effect at the time of connection. The amount previously paid will be credited towards the new Tap Fee.

Added to the fees charged in Item 1 through 4 shall be the actual cost of all highway and county permits.

Eastern Heights Utilities, Inc.
Updated Tap Fee and
New System Development Charge
Approved by the IURC on January 14, 2026

On January 14, 2026, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“IURC”) approved Eastern Heights Utilities, Inc.’s 30-day application for an updated Tap Fee and a new System Development Charge for new consumers connecting to Eastern Heights’ water distribution system. The new Tap Fee and System Development Charge are effective as of January 14, 2026.

A Tap Fee is charged to all Eastern Heights customers who wish to connect to the Eastern Heights water distribution system in a location that currently does not have a meter or meter box connected to the system. The Tap Fee collects the cost of excavating and tapping the main, furnishing and laying service pipe from the main to the property line, corporation and stop cocks, service and meter box, and installing a 5/8-inch meter. The charge for a single 5/8-inch meter tap is \$1,960.00, effective on January 14, 2026. Additional costs for any highway and/or county permits, as well as installation of a meter larger than 5/8-inch, will be the responsibility of the consumer.

The System Development Charge is a new charge for customers that require a new connection to the Eastern Heights water system to pay a fee that will be used to offset the cost of new system water capacity additions that may be required due to the connection. Collection of system development funds will be deposited into a restricted account of funds of which are to be used for capacity-related improvements made necessary by customer growth. The System Development Charge for a 5/8-inch meter will be \$1,500.00, with larger System Development Charges required for larger meter installations.
